- Concentration in academic studies must be relevant to one of the career paths
- Graduated between May of the current year and May of the following year
- Earned a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher and submit an official college transcript
- Demonstrate effective communication and interpersonal skills
- Preference given to candidates with relevant internship experiences
- Ability to begin the National Grid Graduate Program in June (dependent on your graduation date)
- Display leadership experience in at least one of the following:
 - o College leadership position (e.g., student government, clubs, athletics).
 - Leadership and/or volunteer experience, in and/or out of the college environment
 - Experienced a full or part-time job while at college and acquired relevant work experience
